Betsy Hays, APR, will provide you with the tips and techniques to gain confidence and skill in your presentations.

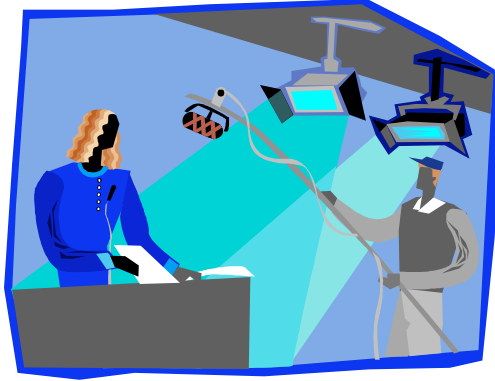
